



The Maine Health Access Foundation's mission is to promote access to quality health care, especially for those who are uninsured and underserved, and improve the health of everyone in Maine.

MeHAF provides about \$4 million in grant and program support annually.

We partner with Maine nonprofits, governments, and other foundations to spread innovative ideas and strategies that advance our mission. Since our creation in 2000, the MeHAF has expended nearly \$70 million and made grants to nearly 400 Maine nonprofit and public organizations to make quality health care available to all Mainers, especially those who face barriers accessing health services or achieving optimal health.

Key Achievements

- Helped over 76,000 Maine people get health insurance through the enroll207.com campaign.
- Helped primary care practices expand capacity for medication-assisted recovery (MAR) for people with opioid use disorder.
- Supported community-based efforts that help older adults and those with chronic illnesses remain healthy and living in their own homes.
- Strengthened the capacity of the oral health safety net and community health center network to expand services for underserved people.
- Spearheaded the development of the country's most comprehensive statewide electronic health information exchanges.
- Piloted a nonprofit finance capacity building program for Maine's nonprofit health advocacy organizations.

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
